

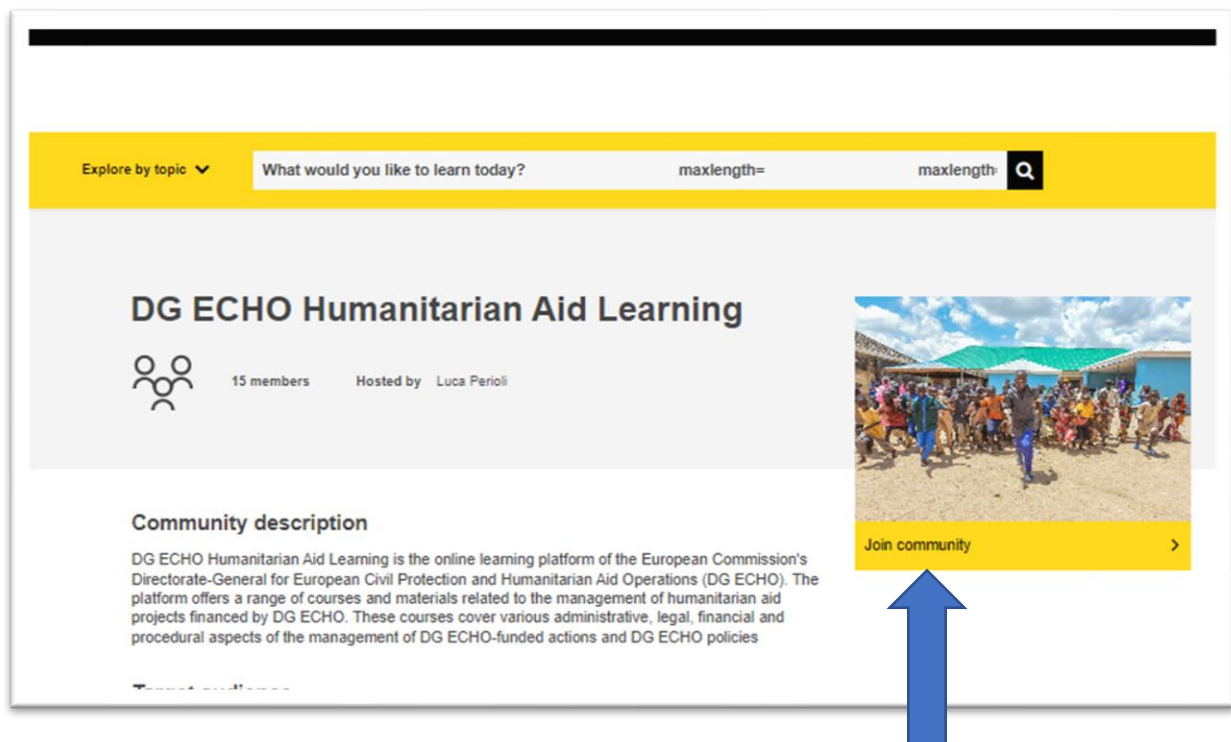
Step-by-Step Guide to Accessing and Enrolling in DG ECHO Humanitarian Aid Learning on EU Academy

Navigating to DG ECHO Humanitarian Aid Learning:

1. Access this [link](#).

Note: Simply click on this link the first time; after completing your registration, you will find the training area on the homepage of your profile.

2. You will find yourself in the DG ECHO Humanitarian Aid Learning area. Click on "**Join community**".



Signing In or Creating an EU Login Account:

3. If you already have an EU Login account, sign in with your credentials.

4. If you don't have an account, follow the procedure to create a new EU Login account.

Explanation of how cookies are used on the EU Academy platform.

To make Commission websites work properly, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website stores on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site.

- First party cookies** are cookies set by the website you're visiting. Only that website can read them. In addition, a website might potentially use external services, which also set their own cookies, known as **third-party cookies**.
- Persistent cookies are cookies saved on your computer and that are not deleted automatically when you quit your browser, unlike a session cookie, which is deleted when you quit your browser.

Every time you visit the Commission's websites, you will be prompted to **accept or refuse cookies**. The purpose is to enable the site to remember your preferences (such as user name, language, etc.) for a certain period of time. That way, you don't have to re-enter them when browsing around the site during the same visit.

How can you manage cookies?

You can **manage/delete** cookies as you wish - for details, see aboutcookies.org.

Removing cookies from your device

You can delete all cookies that are already on your device by clearing the browsing history of your browser. This will remove all cookies from all websites you have visited.

Be aware though that you may also lose some saved information (e.g. saved login details, site preferences).

Managing site-specific cookies

For more detailed control over site-specific cookies, check the privacy and cookie settings in your preferred browser

Blocking cookies

You can set most modern browsers to prevent any cookies being placed on your device, but you may then have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a site/page. And some services and functionalities may not work properly at all (e.g. profile logging-in).
